Geography

Through our topic on 'Our local area', we will find key features within our local area, explore and create maps, find out how Bucknell has changed over time and consider what it may look like in the future.

Computing

We will have online safety updates through Project Evolve and will develop programming skills through Scratch. We will also be exploring computing systems and networks through a focus on the internet.

D&T
