Acorn Class News and Learning

The children have been reading more about castles.

We have also been practising capital letters and full stops, and making posters about castles, writing down key facts.

In RE, the children have been learning more about Judaism, including the importance of Shabat and making Havdalah candles to represent their feelings and emotions.

In science we have been exploring the effects of different surfaces using a car going down a ramp.

In maths, the children have deepened their understanding of money, number bonds and have started with multiplication and division.

Oak Class News and Learning

In English we have been continuing to read the story of Beowulf and have written a biography about Beowulf. What an action-packed life he had! After half term, we will be comparing book and film versions of the legend.

In maths we have been looking at perimeter, area, fractions and ratio. The children have also been deepening their understanding of times tables and related facts.

In topic, we have been looking at the importance of Lindisfarne and also studying Viking weapons and warfare in more detail.

In science, we have been studying lifecycles, which has included how the body changes, the growth of babies and gestation periods for different animals.
