### A Polite Reminder ...

Children should arrive at school between 8.35am and 8.45am. Nursery children should not arrive before 8.45am, unless pre arranged to join Early Birds Nursery Club.

A number of children have been arriving before 8.30am without prior arrangement. This is a staffing and safeguarding concern. It has been arranged that school buses arrive before the main influx of children, so as to minimise the risk of an accident on the driveway and to ease congestion on the roads.
