## **Class News**

#### **Preschool**

The children have been enjoying our topic on mini beasts, this week was National Bee Week. We have read stories about bees on adventures and noisy bees. We have created our own beehive and honeycombs using sponge painting and shapes.

We have the wonderful experience of tasting locally sourced honey, each child loved it. Thank you to Mr and Mrs Theobalds for letting us taste your honey. We highly recommend it.









Please can we remind parents about sun hats and applying sun cream before school. Can we also ask that children wear appropriate footwear. We have had a few trips and slips due to children wearing unsuitable shoes or trainers.

#### Class 1

We've had a good learning week and have been focusing on life cycles of frogs and butterflies in Science, and starting our learning about Islam in RE. I wanted to share with you some photos of a few of the Year 1s and 2s who designed and made some fantastic vehicles in Design and Technology. After initially thinking about different kinds of vehicles, the children learned about wheels, and axles. They used dowel rod with cardboard cuboids and wheels to make a basic chassis. Then came the fun bit- designing and making their own vehicle.

Avah made a fabulous tractor, Summer made a plane, Tristan made a fire engine with a cherry picker and ladders, and Sofia made a Catmobile!! Finally, the children had to evaluate their models and think about the good things and about what they'd like to improve.


#### Class 2 News

During the next session, we used a range of clues to make predictions about the text. Within RE, we have been learning about the story of Pentecost by adding sound effects and flame movements

Our school author partner, Catherine Cooper, popped in this week to present Fin with his prize from last term's book cover design competition: the design has been used for the cover of her new book, The Black Stone. She also announced to the children that she will be working with all of Key Stage Two after half term to write some poetry for a book that she will publish. In other news this week, Year 5 have been tackling decimals and year 6 have been putting the finishing touches to their goblin car in preparation for the next track day at Curborough.


