

RE

We will be using a variety of resources to answer the following questions: For Christians, what was the impact of Pentecost? How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people? Both of these units will be taught through the Shropshire SACRE and the Understanding Christianity units of work.

PSHE & RSE

Through the Jigsaw scheme of work, we will study relationships and Changing Me. These units will enable the children to continue developing their understanding of human relationships and how their bodies change over time.

Computing

We will have Online safety updates through Project Evolve and we will be learning about computing programming through the program Scratch and also learning about the internet.

D&T

We will be exploring electrical design by making a 3D electrical map of our own local area including switches and lights that switch on and off.

English

Our Pathways To Write focus text is Persuasive writing which we will study through the text

GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling)

Science

We will develop our knowledge Electricity and then be learning about magnets, using a variety of observations and investigations. We will aim to apply our knowledge of Electricity through making a model in a practical context.

Maths

We will be using a Power Maths approach to further our understanding of:

- Geometry and Measurement
- Fractions and Shape
