

ENGLISH

This term we will be covering all aspects of the English National Curriculum. Children will still be expected to read and learn spellings at home. The use of EdShed for extra practise is actively encouraged. We will be having an increased focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar as the Year 6 SATS continue to get closer.

The texts we will be looking at are Plastic Planet and Sky Chasers by Emma Carroll. With Plastic Planet, the children will be learning to write persuasively to encourage readers to take better care of the planet.

There will be lots of fiction and non-fiction writing opportunities as we read through Sky Chasers with the children having the opportunity to write their own chapter at the end of the story.



PSHE & RSE

Within our PSHE lessons, we will cover:

- Relationships
- Changing Me

RE

Within RE, we will focus on the following key questions:

What matters most to Humanists and Christians?

Why do some people believe in God and some people not?

MATHS

Throughout the term, we will be looking at consolidating all of this year's learning so far in preparation for the Year 6 SATs.

We also have some key areas still to cover, including ratio, algebra, measures conversions, statistics, angles, shape and position and direction.

MUSIC

COMPUTING

Within our Computing lessons, we will cover:

FRENCH

Alongside regular conversational French, we will be focusing this term on 'At the Tea Room'

We will learn how to say a range of food types and general phrases that you might use in a café.

D&T

Focus this term will be on textiles. By the end of the summer term children will hopefully have created their own Anglo-Saxon money purse.

ART

In art, the children will be creating shadow puppets!

SCIENCE

Children cover the units of Light and Animals including Humans. In the light unit, children will learn about how light travels, reflection, what darkness is, how the human eye works, different light sources and shadows. The animals including humans will be all about animal and human life cycles.

PE

Mr Jones will be covering Football, fitness, cricket, athletics in the summer term.

GEOGRAPHY & HISTORY
